Four new projects to be supported by the ATOZ Foundation in 2016

For four years now, the ATOZ Foundation has supported projects which focus on helping children and young people achieve their goals through education. The ATOZ Foundation will be funding four new education-focused projects in 2016 as well as renewing support for two additional projects.

The new projects include the sponsoring of two scholarships for underprivileged university students in Morocco through the Fondation Marocaine de L'Etudiante, helping a local Luxembourg association, La Main Tendue a.s.b.l Angela, develop a mindfulness programme to help abused children and adolescents, supporting school children in Peru as they learn about responsible farming with CSI Lëtzebuerg, and lastly, a partnership with the Fondation Junclair to help Cambodian street children gain access to education and return to school with the association Mith Samlahn.

Funding will be renewed for both the project "Méi a besser léieren" through the Elizabeth Stiftung which helps socially disadvantaged children reach their educational goals through academic support and the Caritas Luxembourg project "Dys-Positive" which provides children with learning disabilities such as dyslexia specialised therapy.
